This scholarship will provide a **\$250.00** cash award to a qualifying minority student who meets all criteria and intends to enroll in the University of Louisiana at Lafayette in the Fall 2011 semester.

The deadline for the completed application is due on **Thursday, March 11, 2011**. The scholarship will be presented to the student at the BFSC Awards reception on Thursday, March 24, 2011. Money will be disbursed to the student at the beginning of the Fall 2011 semester.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Minimum 23 ACT composite
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Be a member of an ethnic minority group- African American, American Indian, Hispanic American, Asian American, or Hawaiian/Pacific Islander.
- Complete the attached form and return by the deadline (Thursday, March 11, 2011)
- Must be a Louisiana resident
- Must be graduating from a Louisiana high school

Judging Criteria:

- Students are asked to complete all short answer questions and will be judged on current and past campus and community involvement, leadership ability, and personal character that can be judged by the answers to the application questions.
- Answers should be in short paragraph form (4-6 sentences).
- All information should be true and correct to the best of your knowledge.
